



CONSTANCE LE PRINCE MAURICE

A Mixture of the Opulent and the Tropical

Your first encounter with 'The Prince' will be majestic. Its magnificent lobby with soaring vaulted timber roof, floor to ceiling columns and charming Creole-style verandas and shutters, will dwarf you. The design is a mixture of the opulent and the tropical, and this entrance space redefines the term 'grand'

'Le Prince Maurice' occupies 24 hectares of a private peninsula on the island's east coast. Its sheltered position ensures that each of its four golden beaches is well protected year round.

The suites are strung along the beachfront, around luxuriant gardens or elevated on stilts over the lagoon. Each has a thatched roof, polished teak floors, dark timber furniture, teak shutters and a balcony or veranda. The senior suites have private heated plunge pools and direct beach access.

Dining is an equally amazing experience at Mauritius' only floating restaurant, "Le Barachois", the benchmark of fine dining. In a spectacularly beautiful setting, the series of tented dining pontoons are built over a natural lake and reached by a boardwalk winding through mangrove trees. Each pontoon has just a handful of tables and the atmosphere is as serene as it is romantic.

The spa is lavish and the resort's Body Doctor can customise a special fitness and dietary program to get you into top gear.

Golfing enthusiasts have a full range of activities to choose from at two nearby championship golf courses, The Legend and The Links Courses.

Children are treated like royalty, of course, in the 'Little Princes Club'.
