

LE TOUESSROK

A pocket sized paradise

You'll know you've found paradise when you arrive at Le Touessrok.

A smartly dressed attendant in crisp white uniform will greet you at a grand portico and lead you through a high stone archway to a verdant garden on the edge of a magnificent bay.

Le Touessrok sits on a tiny point mid-way down the island's east coast. It is lapped by water on three sides and has five perfect white sandy beaches.

Its 203 deluxe rooms, suites and villas spread over the mainland peninsula and nearby Frangipani Island, a tiny palm fringed enclave accessed by a wooden bridge. Guests also have access to the private island of Ilot Mangenie, a five-minute boat ride away, as well as Île aux Cerfs, which has the best beaches in Mauritius. The main water sports take place at Île aux Cerfs, also home to the 18-hole Touessrok Golf Course.

The deluxe rooms are in two wings on the mainland, the suites with expansive terraces on Frangipani Island and the luxurious three bedroom villas is in a quiet locale at the end of the giant sweep of Hibiscus Beach. Each room has an ocean view and 24-hour butler service. Special touches include walk-in monsoon showers, oval bathtubs and infinity pools in the villas.

The dining options are diverse; the main 'Three-Nine-Eight' restaurant has eight show kitchens, while alternative restaurants serve Japanese and Indian cuisine.

While parents indulge in a 'ylang-ylang' massage, a heavenly treat performed by two therapists delivering a mirror-imaged massage on both sides of the body, the little ones can attend golf, tennis, windsurfing and swimming clinics, if they so wish.
