



LE TELFAIR GOLF & SPA RESORT

Gleaming White Resort on the South Coast

A stay at Le Telfair Golf & Spa Resort provides an instant entrée into a slice of Mauritian history. This gleaming white resort on the south coast is on the former grand sugar estate of Bel Ombre.

The resort's design which groups six and eight rooms, and suites, into 20 two-storey villas, is a modern take on a colonial village. The resort fronts a coral-fringed lagoon divided through by the Citronniers River, giving guests a choice between sea or river view accommodation.

The jewel in the Bel Ombre crown is Le Chateau Restaurant, located a short distance away in the former Manor House of the sugar estate. Built in the early 1800s, it has been meticulously restored and is the place to enjoy lunch, a classic afternoon tea or gastronomic French specialities at dinner.

A visit to the Six Senses Spa is a must and a chance to experience the signature 'sensory spa journey', a 90-minute four-hand massage that begins with the feet and ends in pure bliss. Set amidst tropical gardens, ponds and water features that soothe the calm and assist in balancing the senses.

The Golf du Chateau is a stunning course carved out of the old sugar fields. It comprises an 18-hole par 72 championship course and a nine-hole short course, practice, driving range and clubhouse with restaurant and bar.

One of the joys of a stay at Telfair is the proximity to 'green Mauritius'; the island's rivers, waterfalls and unique mountain landscapes, only a short drive away.
