The spa is a haven of serious pampering. A truly unforgettable experience is the Paillasson pure indulgence body scrub, which uses the coconut husk and oil in an hour-long ritual involving a blissful body brush and deep massage.

Dining at the Oberoi is equally indulgent; savour the Creole, European and Oriental delights at the grand indoor-outdoor restaurant with soaring timber and thatched roof, or reconnect with your loved one with an intimate dinner under the stars, on the water's edge.
