



## LABRIZ SILHOUETTE

### *Perfect Views of Mount Dauban*

It is thought to be the most densely vegetated island in the Indian Ocean and at sunset is seen as a striking silhouette from the nearby Island of Mahé. The island of Silhouette is dominated by the peak of Mount Dauban, which is surrounded by virgin rain forest and botanical treasures.

Labriz Silhouette, one chic contemporary resort comprising 93 villas and 17 pavilions, is positioned on the east side of the island between the view of the mountain and the open lagoon.

The Garden Villas enjoy perfect views of Mount Dauban while the larger Beach Villas are tucked into the vegetation and just steps away from Anse la Passe, an inviting two-kilometre stretch of powdery sand beach. The 17 Villa Pavilions are the largest and most decadent with an outdoor dining pavilion for candlelit diners and a generous pool for cooling off, set amidst private gardens. The interiors are light coral tones, with generous space and wonderful bathrooms.

The Aquum Spa has a spectacular setting, built on and around iconic granite boulders. The signature ritual, "Kreol Inspiration" is a body smoothing and conditioning ritual using warm brown sugar and nutmeg polish smoothed over a green coffee and coconut wrap, finished with a creamy, spiced coconut hair mask and intuitive massage.

More Creole specialities are found in the restaurant set in a restored 1850's plantation house. The Portobello restaurant serves modern Italian cuisine, while Sakura, spectacularly located in the centre of the lagoon, specialises in fresh seafood prepared in a show kitchen.

Resort activities include diving and snorkelling, mountain walks and tennis, sailing and big game fishing.
